

M I N U T E S
STUDIES COMMITTEE
OF THE
LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

August 11, 1981

The meeting of the Studies Committee of the Legislative Council was called to order by Chairperson Representative Larry Pope at 10:15 a.m., Tuesday, August 11, 1981, in the Speaker's Room of the State House, Des Moines, Iowa. Committee members present in addition to Chairperson Pope were:

Also present were Mr. Serge Garrison, Director, Mr. Burnette Koebernick and Ms. Debbie Dahab of the Legislative Service Bureau, various legislative staff and other interested persons.

On a motion from Senator Hultman the minutes of the July 7 meeting were approved as written. Senator Hultman then moved that the Studies Committee recommend that the Legislative Council authorize the establishment of an interim subcommittee to study city civil service as outlined in Senate Concurrent Resolutions 18 and 37 and House Concurrent Resolution 33. The motion included the provision that the subcommittee consist of ten members and be authorized one meeting day. The motion was approved unanimously. Senator Hultman then moved that the members of the City Civil Service Subcommittee be as follows: Representatives Tyrrell (Chair), Crabb, Diemer, Connors and Renaud and Senators Readinger, Carney and Waldstein with the remaining two senators to be appointed by Senator Junkins prior to the afternoon Legislative Council meeting.

The Committee considered and unanimously approved as a recommendation to the Legislative Council the members chosen for each subcommittee as designated on a list circulated by the Legislative Service Bureau with the exception that on the Elderly Abuse and Elderly Service Program Study Representative Arnould be substituted for Representative Connors. The Legislative Service Bureau was also instructed to cross-check its list with lists provided by the House and Senate party caucuses to verify the membership. The meeting was adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
