STUDIES COMMITTEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

October 16, 1991

PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

The Studies Committee of the Legislative Council was called to order by Acting Chairperson Senator Wally Horn at 10:41 a.m. on Wednesday, October 16, 1991, in Senate Room 22 of the State Capitol Building, Des Moines, Iowa. In addition to Acting Chairperson Horn, the following Committee members were present:

Also present were staff members from the Legislative Service Bureau, Legislative Fiscal Bureau, Research and Caucus Staffs, and other interested persons.

Acting Chairperson Horn moved the adoption of the minutes of the September 25, 1991, meeting of the Studies Committee, as previously distributed to the members. The motion was adopted by voice vote.

INTERIM STUDY COMMITTEE REQUESTS

Acting Chairperson Horn suggested that the eight interim study committee requests be considered and voted upon as a whole. The original requests are on file with the Legislative Service Bureau. Speaker Arnould moved that the request of the Government Efficiency and Operations Study Committee for extension of the November 1, 1991, completion deadline to January 13, 1992, be changed to December 20, 1991. There being no objections, the motion was approved.

Senator Lind moved that the Legislative Service Bureau staff negotiate the expenses proposed to be paid from moneys appropriated pursuant to section 2.12 for the National Conference of State Legislatures staff presentation at the October 17 Statutory Budget Limitation Study Subcommittee. The motion was approved without objection. Representative McKinney then moved that approval of the interim study committee requests, as amended, be recommended to the Legislative Council. The motion was approved without objection.

The interim study committee requests recommended by the Studies Committee for approval by the Legislative Council are included in the report of the Studies Committee to the Legislative Council. The report is attached and by this reference made a part of these minutes.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Committee, it was moved and adopted that the Committee adjourn at 10:46 a.m.
