PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

MINUTES APPROVED

Senator Hutchins moved that the minutes of the April 24, 1990, meeting be approved as distributed to the Committee. The motion carried on a unanimous voice vote.

PERSONNEL/ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT OF THE OFFICE OF CITIZENS' AIDE

Chairperson Welsh recognized Mr. William Angrick, Citizens' Aide, for presentation of his report. A copy of the report is on file in the Legislative Service Bureau. Mr. Angrick stated that, since the resignation of Legal Counsel Michael Elliott, some reassignment of duties has been necessary. Mr. Angrick stated that he has reassigned Ms. Ruth Mosher, who is currently the office Intake/Rapid Resolution Team Leader, to the position of Investigative Team Leader and that he, Mr. Angrick, will be assuming the responsibilities of Intake/Rapid Resolution Team Leader. Chairperson Welsh asked for unanimous consent to receive

and file the report. No objection was made and the report was received and filed.

PERSONNEL REPORT OF THE LEGISLATIVE FISCAL BUREAU

Chairperson Welsh recognized Mr. Dennis Prouty, Director of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, for presentation of his report. A copy of the report is on file in the Legislative Service Bureau. Mr. Prouty noted that his report consisted of one item, that being notification of a merit salary increase for Mr. Jonathan Neiderbach, Senior Legislative Analyst. Chairperson Welsh asked for unanimous consent to receive and file the report. No objection was made and the report was received and filed.

PERSONNEL REPORT OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU

Chairperson Welsh recognized Ms. Diane Bolender, Director of the Legislative Service Bureau, for presentation of her report. A copy of the report is on file in the Legislative Service Bureau. Ms. Bolender stated that her report consisted of notification that Ms. Jonetta Douglas, Legislative Librarian, has successfully completed her probationary period and that both Ms. Douglas and Ms. Susan Weddell, Legislative Text Processor, have been granted merit salary increases. Chairperson Welsh asked for unanimous consent to receive and file the report. No objection was made and the report was received and filed.

REPORT OF THE COMPUTER OVERSIGHT SUBCOMMITTEE

Chairperson Welsh recognized Senator Bill Hutchins for presentation of the report of the Computer Oversight Subcommittee. Senator Hutchins orally reported the actions of the Computer Oversight Subcommittee. Senator Hutchins noted that the Subcommittee has requested Mr. Sanford Scharf, Director of the Computer Support Bureau, to solicit additional bids for equipment designed to assure power source continuity for the legislative computer and that Mr. Scharf would be making a report to the Oversight Subcommittee at its next meeting. Senator Hutchins also stated that the Computer Support Bureau reported that it will be purchasing additional personal computer equipment for the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, Legislative Service Bureau, and House and Senate staffs. Senator Hutchins moved that the Committee receive and file the report. The motion carried on a unanimous voice vote.

OTHER BUSINESS AND ADJOURNMENT

Chairperson Welsh asked whether there was any other business to come before the Committee. There was no additional business and Senator Hultman moved that the Committee adjourn. The motion carried on a unanimous voice vote and the Committee adjourned at 10:46 a.m.
