STUDIES COMMITTEE

December 20, 1983

The meeting of the Studies Committee of the Legislative Council was called to order by the Studies Committee Chairman, Senator Lowell L. Junkins, at 1:55 p.m., Tuesday, December 20, 1983, in Committee Room 22 of the State House, Des Moines, Iowa. Members present in addition to Senator Junkins were:

Chairman Junkins inquired as to whether there are additions or corrections to the minutes of the last meeting. Senator Miller moved that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as distributed. The motion was seconded and adopted unanimously on a voice vote.

Chairman Junkins noted that the items before the Committee today include a request for one additional meeting day for the Economic Development and Jobs Training Study Committee and a request for one additional meeting day for the Grain Dealers and Lien Law Study Committee. Senator Hutchins moved that one additional meeting day be recommended by the Studies Committee to the Legislative Council for approval for the Economic Development and Jobs Training Study Committee and the Grain Dealers and Lien Law Study Committee. The motion was seconded by Senator Briles and approved unanimously on a voice vote.

There being no further business before the Studies Committee, the meeting of the Studies Committee was adjourned at 1:58 p.m.
