STUDIES COMMITTEE

December 10, 1985

PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

The seventh meeting of the Studies Committee of the Iowa Legislative Council was called to order by the Chairman, Speaker Donald D. Avenson, at 2:40 p.m., December 10, 1985 in Senate Room 22, State House, Des Moines, Iowa. Members present in addition to Chairman Avenson were:

Also present were Mr. Donovan Peeters, Director, Legislative Service Bureau; Mr. Thane R. Johnson, Senior Research Analyst, Legislative Service Bureau; representatives of the news media, other legislative staff, and other interested persons.

Chairman Avenson recognized Senator Holt who moved to dispense with the roll call. The motion was adopted. Senator Holt also moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the November 20th meeting and the minutes were approved as submitted. The motion as adopted.

CHAIRMAN'S RECOMMENDATIONS

Chairman Avenson stated that he makes the following recommendations concerning the requests for meeting days:

- 1. The request by the Joint Human Services Appropriations Subcommittees be deferred.
- 2. The request for one meeting day by the Water Quality Study Committee to meet during the first three days of the 1986 Session be approved.
- 3. The one meeting day request by the Alternative Crops and Livestock Study Committee to finalize goals, work plans, and request meeting days during its first meeting of the 1986 interim study be approved.

4. Three additional meeting days for the Collective Bargaining Study Committee be approved. Chairman Avenson stated that the Collective Bargaining Study Committee has already used two meeting days and one additional meeting is scheduled. He stated that the Study Committee is composed of nonlegislative members and that they were unaware that they were to request additional meeting days.

RECOMMENDATIONS ADOPTED

There being no further comments, Senator Coleman moved that the recommendations of Chairman Avenson be adopted as recommendations of the Studies Committee. The motion was seconded by Representative Welden and adopted.

There being no further business to come before the Studies Committee, Senator Holt moved that the Studies Committee adjourn at 2:45 p.m. The motion was adopted.
