March 2, 1979

Action on the minutes of the Council's February 22 meeting was deferred.

Chairperson Millen distributed to Council members present a list of suggested appointments to three of the Council's statutory or affiliated committees, the Administration Committee and Service Committee of the Council and the Legislative Fiscal Committee. Senator Hultman moved that the list of suggested appointments distributed by Chairperson Millen be approved. The motion was seconded by Representative Harbor and adopted by a unanimous voice vote.

In response to an inquiry by Representative Avenson, Chairperson Millen stated that the Studies Committee of the Council will be appointed at a later date. He added that he also intends to appoint a Council subcommittee to review and consider the possible

need for revisions in the state employees' educational leave statute, pursuant to the action taken by the Council at its previous meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned.
