The Ways and Means Committee was called to order by Chair Vander Linden at 1:00 pm.

Both parties went to caucus. The committee reconvened at 2:00 pm.

Roll Call was taken with a quorum present.

As there were no corrections, amendments, and/or deletions to the May 1 meeting minutes, Chair Vander Linden moved to approve the minutes as distributed. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Bloomingdale for opening comments on SF 2400, an act relating to municipal risk protection and the classification of library districts as municipalities for the purpose of joining a local government risk pool and including effective provisions.

Discussion followed. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Bloomingdale for closing comments on <u>SF 2400</u> and Representative Bloomingdale moved the bill. <u>SF 2400</u> passed by a vote of 24 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent, as a Senate File.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Holt for opening comments on <u>SF</u> <u>2407</u>, an act modifying the rebate of sales and use tax to the owner or operator of a raceway facility and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions. Discussion followed. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Holt for closing comments on <u>SF 2407</u> and Representative Holt moved the bill. <u>SF 2407</u> passed by a vote of 24 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent, as a Senate File.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Mohr for opening comments on HSB 696, an act relating to the workforce housing tax incentives program by providing for limited extensions of completion deadlines for housing projects and including applicability provisions.

Discussion followed. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Mohr for closing comments on <u>HSB 696</u> and Representative Mohr moved the bill. <u>HSB 696</u> passed by a vote of 24 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent and moves to the House floor as a committee bill.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Baltimore for opening comments on SF 2390, an act relating to licensure and regulation for the hotel sanitation code, home bakeries and food establishments and food processing plants, modifying fees and penalties, and including effective provisions.

Discussion followed. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Baltimore for closing comments on <u>SF 2390</u> and Representative Baltimore moved the bill. <u>SF 2390</u> passed by a vote of 24 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent and moves to the House floor as a Senate File.

Representative Kurth motioned for immediate consideration of HF 2418. Chair

Vander Linden declined. Representative Kurth then moved to suspend the rules for immediate consideration of <u>HF 2418</u>. The motion failed on a vote of 13 nays and 11 ayes (Bloomingdale, Jacoby, Bennett, Forbes, Gaskill, Isenhart, Kearns, Kurth, McConkey, Prichard, Wolfe), 1 absent.

With no other business to come before the Committee, Representative Kaufmann moved to arise at 2:15 pm.
