SF 46, as amended, passed on a roll call vote 8-4 as a committee bill with Senators

Rozenboom, Shipley, Behn, Cournoyer, Kapucian, Segebart, Sweeney, and Zumbach voting yes and Senators Boulton, Celsi, Lykam, and J. Smith voting no.
