Chairman Carlson called for the vote and moved [HSB 5](#), as amended, forward as a committee bill on a vote of 13 ayes and 10 nays (Nielsen, Forbes, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Kressig, McConkey, Meyer, Oldson, Williams).

Representative Mohr was recognized to take up [HSB 40](#). Rep. Mohr gave opening comments and there was discussion. Rep. Mohr gave closing comments and moved the bill. Chairman Carlson moved [HSB 40](#), as a committee bill on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 23 ayes and 0 nays.
