Meeting was called to order at 1:06 by Chairman Dolecheck.

Attendance was read and a quorum was present.

The minutes were approved from the previous meeting.

The meeting stood at ease for both parties to caucus at 1:10 pm.

The meeting reconvened at 1:45 pm.

Chairman Dolecheck recognized Representative Meyer for opening comments on [HSB 128](#). (An Act relating to a financial literacy requirement under the state's educational standards).

Discussion regarding [HSB 128](#).

After discussion and closing comments on [HSB 128](#), Representative Meyers moved the bill.

The House Study Bill passed with a Vote of 22 YEA to 1 NAY and 0 ABSENT. [HSB 128](#) will move to the House Floor as an Education committee bill.

Representative Dolecheck recognized Vice Chair Gassman to take over role as Chair.

Opening comments by Chairman Dolecheck of [HSB 18](#) (An Act relating to school funding by modifying provisions relating to the collection of sales tax for deposit in the secure an advanced vision for education fund, provisions relating to and prerequisites for the use of tax revenue from the secure an advanced vision for education fund, and provisions relating to the calculation of the additional property tax levy, and making appropriations).

Vice Chair Gassman recognized Chairman Dolecheck for opening comments on Amendment 25. After discussion and closing comments on Amendment 25, Dolecheck moved the Amendment 25 and was passed on short form.

After further discussion and closing comments on [HSB 18](#) as amended, Representative Dolecheck moved the bill, [HSB 18](#), as amended. [HSB 18](#) as amended passed on the vote 21 YEA, 2 NAY, 0 ABSENT. [HSB 18](#) as amended will pass onto the House floor as an Education committee bill.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Staed moved to adjourn at 2:00 pm.
