Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Osmundson for opening remarks on [HSB 166](#): ***A bill for an act requestion the establishment of an interim study committee relating to the impact of state assistance program income restriction guidelines.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on [HF 294](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the brain injury home and community-based services waiver monthly budget maximum.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on [HSB 158](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the practice of polysomnography.***
