The clerk called the vote 12 (aye)-9 (nay) 0 (absent) with the nay votes being Representatives Wolfe, Bennett, Derry, Konfrst, Meyer, Oldson, Olson, Sunde, Wessel-Kroeschell. [HF 233](#) passed as a committee bill.

[HSB 41](#)- Chairperson Holt recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments.

Discussion was now open. Representative Kaufmann motioned for adoption of Amendment 401. Amendment 401 was divided. The Amendment passed. With no further discussion, Chairperson Holt recognized Representative Kaufmann for closing comments. The clerk called the vote 21 (aye)-0 (nay) 0 (absent).
