Chairwoman Lundgren called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

There were corrections noted in the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were amended and the minutes were approved as amended.

The meeting reconvened at 2:35 pm.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on [HF 435](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the release of certain confidential information by the department of human services to multidisciplinary teams and making penalties applicable.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Osmundson for opening remarks on [HSB 183](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the integration of Medicaid and health and well kids in Iowa program eligibility, payment, and administrative functions under the department of human services.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on [HSB 184](#): ***A bill for an act relating to juvenile justice, including provisions relating to child foster care and parent visitation in child in need of assistance proceedings.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on [HSB 200](#): ***A bill for an act relating to prior authorization for medication-assisted treatment under the Medicaid program.***

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on amendment 200.480. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on [HF 451](#): ***A bill***

for an act esbablishing a psychiatric patient placement clearinghouse and inpatient psychiatric bed tracking system work group.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
