Chairwoman Lundgren called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

The meeting stood at ease for both parties to caucus at 1:32 pm.

The meeting reconvened at 1:57 pm.

There was a correction noted and made to the minutes from the previous meeting. The minutes were unanimously approved as amended.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on [HSB 238](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the dispensing fee for partially dispensed prescriptions.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 18 Aye, 3 Nay, and 0 Absent. Those voting no were Representatives Brown-Powers, Heddens, and Matson. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on [HF 619](#): ***A bill for an Act relating to the notification of law enforcement regarding the discharge of a voluntary patient who is mentally ill or has symptoms of mental illness from a hospital.***

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on amendment 619.734. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
