Amendment 1035.30 was introduced by Senator Sinclair and commented on by Senator Dawson then passed via voice vote. <u>SSB 1035</u> as amended was discussed and comments were made by Senator Mathis, Senator Quirmbach, and Senator Bolkcom and following closing comments was passed with a record roll call. Senator Chapman was recognized to introduce <u>SSB 1202</u>. Senator Bolkcom and Senator Mathis
