SERVICE COMMITTEE

November 11, 1982

The meeting of the Service Committee of the Legislative Council was called to order at 1:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 11, 1982 in Committee Room 22 of the State House, Des Moines. Committee members present were:

Mr. Prouty announced that the Legislative Fiscal Bureau presently has two vacancies and he asked for approval that one of the vacancies be filled by the employment of Ms. Kathleen Mabie to staff the State Government Appropriations Subcommittee and perform some administrative work with the fiscal notes. He asked that Ms. Mabie be employed as a Legislative Fiscal Analyst at Pay Grade 24, and a starting salary of \$17,430.40. Representative Connors moved that the Service Committee recommend that the employment of Ms. Mabie be approved by the Legislative Council. Senator Tieden seconded the motion, and it carried.

Representative Connors asked whether the other vacancy in the Legislative Fiscal Bureau will also be filled. Mr. Prouty responded in the negative, commenting that if it becomes necessary to implement an across-the-board appropriations reduction, it is necessary to leave the position vacant in order to have money for the reduction.

Senator Tieden asked whether the Legislative Fiscal Bureau is still located in both the Capitol and the Lucas Building. Mr. Prouty responded in the affirmative, commenting that five employees remain in the Lucas State Office Building.

Mr. Garrison asked for approval to employ Ms. Debbie Dahab as a temporary bill drafter starting approximately December 1 and continuing through the legislative session. He commented that he has three new staff persons who have not had previous experience in bill drafting and Ms. Dahab is an excellent bill drafter and can serve as a back-up person to many members of the staff. He asked that she be employed at the base pay of a Research Analyst III,

which is Pay Grade 32 and an annual salary of \$24,398.40. Senator Baugher moved that the Service Committee recommend that the employment of Ms. Dahab be approved by the Legislative Council. Senator Hutchins seconded the motion, and it carried.

Mr. Angrick asked for approval to employ Mr. William J. Hornbostel as the Legal Analyst in the Office of Citizens' Aide. He noted that Mr. Hornbostel has several years of experience in the legal field and asked that he be employed at Pay Grade 29, and an annual salary of \$22,089.60 which is equivalent to the annual salary earned by the previous Legal Analyst at her resignation. Senator Hutchins moved that the Service Committee recommend that the employment of Mr. Hornbostel be approved by the Legislative Council. Representative Connors seconded the motion, and it carried.

The Service Committee adjourned at 1:14 p.m.
