SERVICE COMMITTEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

August 17, 1977

Senator William D. Palmer, Chairperson, called the meeting of the Service Committee of the Legislative Council to order at 12:55 p.m., Wednesday, August 17, 1977 in Senate Room 22, State House, Des Moines, Iowa. Members present in addition to Chairperson Palmer were:

Chairperson Palmer stated that the purpose of the meeting is to review a job announcement for the position of Executive Secretary of the Temporary State Land Preservation Policy Commission as prepared by the Legislative Service Bureau. He further stated that House File 210 does not specifically state when the position of Executive Secretary is to be filled; however, the Legislative Council is charged with the responsibility of appointing the Executive Secretary and the position should be filled to allow the appointee the time necessary to follow the public hearings and work of the county land policy commissions and prepare information for use of the state commission which will organize in April, 1978.

After reviewing the proposed job announcement, it was a consensus of the Committee that applications should be accepted until October 1, 1977, that the proposed salary should be left open, and that the job announcement should be disseminated to the Iowa Merit Employment Department and to Councils of Governments and Regional Planning Commissions, news services and sources of potential applicants.

After further discussion, Senator Phil Hill moved that the proposed job announcement as amended to remove reference to a specific salary range and to accept applications until October 1 be adopted and that Mr. William Greiner, Director, Department of Soil Conservation, be included as an advisory member of the Committee for the purpose of reviewing applications and interviewing applicants.
