- Senator Breitbach called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.
- Attendance was taken silently by the committee secretary.
- Minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.
- Both parties caucused at 1:05 p.m., returning at 1:20 p.m.
- Senator Breitbach turned the Chair over to Senator Kraayenbrink, who recognized him for consideration of [SSB 1262](#). Senator Breitbach moved to dissolve into Subcommittee of the whole for consideration of [SSB 1262](#) and the Chair recognized him for opening remarks. Following his opening remarks he noted that there was an Amendment, 2302. Senator Kraayenbrink then recognized Senator Breitbach for Amendment 2302. The Chair asked for any discussion on the amendment. Seeing none, Senator Breitbach was recognized for closing remarks on Amendment 2302 and a short form vote was requested. Amendment 2302 passed unanimously.
- Back on [SSB 1262](#), as amended, the Chair asked for any discussion. Senator Bolkcom offered remarks. Senator Breitbach was then recognized for closing comments on the bill, as amended. A short form vote was requested and [SSB 1262](#), as amended, passed unanimously.
- The Chair recognized Senator Breitbach, who moved to arise from Subcommittee of the whole and return to Full Committee for consideration of [SSB 1262](#). He had no opening remarks and there were no questions or comments. Senator Breitbach presented amendment 2302. He offered no further remarks, and there was no discussion. A short form vote was requested on amendment 2302 and it was unanimously approved. The Chair recognized Senator Breitbach for closing remarks on [SSB 1262](#), as amended, and a short form vote was requested. [SSB 1262](#), as amended, passed unanimously and will move to the calendar as a Committee bill under Rule 40.
- Senator Kraayenbrink then turned the Chair back over to Senator Breitbach, who thanked the Vice Chair, Senator Kraayenbrink and the Ranking member, Senator Bolkcom, for their excellent work and all Committee members and staff for their hard work and camaraderie.
- With no further business to come before the Committee, Senator Dotzler moved to arise at 1:30p.m.
