Roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Chairman Mohr introduced Annette Dunn, the state's Chief Information Officer as the guest speaker. CIO Dunn presented information regarding the current condition of the State of Iowa's Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Systems and outlined an optimization plan.

CIO Dunn discussed the I/3 system (Integrated Information for Iowa) and HRIS (Human Resources Information System), both currently in use. CIO Dunn discussed issues with both systems as well as concerns with the Mainframe's condition.

Next, CIO Dunn outlined the plan to replace both the I/3 system and HRIS with a modern, cloud-based ERP platform known as "Workday."
