A presentation was given on Iowa's Immunization Registry Information System (IRIS) by Don Callaghan, Chief of the Bureau of Immunization and Tuberculosis. Discussion and questions followed the presentation.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Best for opening remarks on [HSB 532](#): *A bill for an act relating to controlled substances, including information collection and reporting requirements under the Iowa prescription monitoring program.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on [HSB 534](#): *A bill for an act relating to the definition of young adult for purposes of participation in the preparation for adult living program.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on amendment [HSB 534.2624](#). The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on [HF 2031](#): *A bill for an act relating to the licensed health professional member of a local board of health.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on [HF 2073](#): *A bill for an act relating to the Medicaid institutions for mental diseases waiver, and including effective date provisions.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to

the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
