Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on [HSB 535](#): *A bill for an Act modifying duties to prescribe practices and procedures for implementation of a preapplication screening assessment program relating to the involuntary commitment or treatment of a person with a substance-related disorder.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on [HSB 2026](#): *A bill for an Act relating to requirements for physicians providing services at an ambulatory surgical center, and providing penalties.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2026](#).2774. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on [HSB 2066](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the licensure of amulatory surgical centers, providing for fees to be considered repayment receipts, and providing penalties.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2066](#).2784. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on [HSB 2122](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the information to be disclosed by a health care provider as part of a referral of a patient to an ambulatory surgical center, and providing penalties.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Brink for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2122](#).2777. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on [HSB 2115](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the percentage of students who are residents of Iowa or who attend postsecondary institutions in Iowa and are accepted to graduate and postgraduate studies at the state university of Iowa college of medicine or college of dentistry.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2115](#).2778. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 11 Aye, 10 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
