Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on amendment HF 2089.2782. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on <u>HF 2157</u>: A bill for an act relating to requirements for licensees under the purview of the dental board relating to orthodontia services.

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on amendment HF 2157.2879. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on HF 2203: A bill for an act establishing a graduated elgibility phase-out program for state child care assistance.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on HF 2262: A bill for an act relating to health data including the collection and use of hospital data and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions.

with a vote of 19 Aye, 2 Nay, and 0 Absent (Nay votes were Representative Anderson and
