Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on [HF 2089](#): *A bill for an act relating to continuity of care and nonmedical switching by health carriers, health benefit plans, and utilization review organizations, and including applicability provisions.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2089](#).2782. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on [HF 2157](#): *A bill for an act relating to requirements for licensees under the purview of the dental board relating to orthodontia services.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2157](#).2879. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on [HF 2203](#): *A bill for an act establishing a graduated eligibility phase-out program for state child care assistance.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on [HF 2262](#): *A bill for an act relating to health data including the collection and use of hospital data and including effective date and retroactive applicability provisions.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on amendment [HF 2262](#).2894. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 19 Aye, 2 Nay, and 0 Absent (Nay votes were Representative Anderson and Representative Brown-Powers). The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee, Representative Bacon moved to adjourn at 2:00 pm.
