Senator Johnson, Co-Chairman, called the meeting to order at 10:06a.

Roll call was taken silently. All members were present.

The draft meeting minutes were distributed prior to the meeting. Representative Cohoon moved to approve the minutes. Senator Dawson seconded. The minutes were approved as distributed.

Director Judy Bradshaw, Assistant Director Rachael Krier, and Assistant Director Jerry Ingrisano gave a presentation on the needs for the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy (ILEA).

The ILEA requests \$280,000 from the Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund for furniture, \$550,000 from the Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund for parking lot resurfacing, and \$400,000 from the Technology Resource Fund for classroom technology.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the floor was opened for questions by the members.

Chris Kramer, Director, Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs, Veronica O'Hern, Grants Manager, Iowa Arts Council & Iowa Great Places, Heather Riley, Executive Director, Madison County Chamber of Commerce, Winterset, and Dr. Robert Alsop, President, Waldorf College, Forest City, gave a presentation on the Iowa Great Places program. Director Kramer requested \$1,000,000 in funding.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the floor was opened for questions by the members.

With no further business, Representative Hinson moved to arise. The meeting was adjourned at 10:58a by Senator Johnson.
