As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the previous meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Bacon for opening remarks on <u>HSB 533</u>: *A bill for an act relating to the practice of pharmacy, and providing for a repeal.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Best for opening remarks on <u>HSB 582</u>: A bill for an act relating to dispensing fees and copayments for partially dispensed quantities of prescription drugs.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Best for opening remarks on <u>HSB 685</u>: *A bill for an act relating to pharmacy benefits managers and prescription drug prices, and including applicability provisions.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Bacon for opening remarks on <u>HF 2118</u>: *A bill for an act relating to protections for certain potential recipients of anatomical gifts.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Bacon for opening remarks on amendment <u>HF 2118.3165</u>. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on <u>HF 2295</u>: *A* bill for an act relating to transfer between trusts for persons with disabilities.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Salmon for opening remarks on <u>HF 2296</u>: *A bill for an act relating to child fatality protocol and alleged child abuse.*

<u>HF 2296</u>.3196. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Best for opening remarks on <u>HSB 702</u>: *A bill for an act relating to the practice and licensure of physician assistants.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Best for opening remarks on amendment <u>HSB 702</u>.3129. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 21 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on <u>HF 2151</u>: *A bill for an act relating to mental health and disability services regions.*

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on amendment <u>HF 2151.3017</u>. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 11 Aye, 10 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
