Representative Bossman, Co-Chairman, called the meeting to order at 10:13 A.M.

Roll call was taken. Representatives Bennett and Thourp were excused.

The minutes of the previous meeting were distributed electronically to the members. The minutes were approved as distributed.

John Cool, Assistant Administrator for the Iowa School for the Deaf presented on the Long Hall Renovation Update and the Girl's Dorm & Health Center Renovations. The Iowa School for the Deaf is requesting a \$4,800,000 in order to upgrade accessibility, safety, electrical, and HVAC systems.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the floor was opened for questions by the members.

Mike Zwanziger, Assistant Vice President and Director of Facilities Management for the University of Northern Iowa presented on the FY21 Capital Appropriation Request. The University of Northern Iowa is requesting a total of \$39,720,000 (FY 21 - \$1,000,000; FY 22 - \$15,897,000; and FY 23 \$22,823,000) to modernize the Industrial Technology Center.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the floor was opened for questions by the members.

Rod Lehnertz, Senior Vice President of Finance and Operations for the University of Iowa presented on a Capital Project Appropriation Request. The University of Iowa is requesting \$88,000,000 to update and modernize the MacLean, Jessup, and MacBride buildings located on the Pentacrest of the University.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the floor was opened for questions by the members.

Pam Cain, Interim Senior Vice President for Operations & Finance and Dr. Laura Jolly, Dean of the College of Human Science from Iowa State University presented an appropriation request for the La Baron Mackay Complex on Iowa State University's Campus. Iowa State University is requesting a \$30,000,000 appropriation for partial demolition, reconstruction, and modernization of the complex.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the floor was opened for questions by the members.

Representative Kurtz moved to arise.
