As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the previous meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on <u>SF 2261</u>: A bill for an act relating to the provision of behavioral health services including via telehealth in a school setting.

Chairwomen Lundgren recognized Representative Meyer, A for opening remarks on amendment <u>SF 2261</u>.3645. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 19 Aye, 1 Nay, and 1 Absent (The nay vote was Representative Salmon). The bill will move to the House Floor as a Senate File.

The chair was turned over to Representative Meyer, A.

Chairwoman Meyer, A recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on SF 2283: A bill for an act relating to authorized training programs for certain emergency medical care providers and including effective date provisions.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Senate File.

The chair was turned back over to Representative Lundgren.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on SF 2327:A bill for an act relating to the elimination of the hospital licensing board, and providing for repeals.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Senate File.
