Representative Deyoe made a statement regarding rules for the Labor Committee for the current legislative session.

Recess at 3:10 in order to Caucus.

Committee reconvened at 3:15.

Committee Chair Representative Deyoe made a motion to adopt the rules for the committee.

Committee Ranking Member Representative Hunter introduced an amendment to the rules to require masks to be worn by all members during labor committee meetings.

Representative Cahill stated that the Department of Public Health, which the Legislature provides funding for, recommends masks be worn and social distancing be enforced, and that their recommendations should be followed.

Representative Kurth stated that over 1800 new cases of Covid-19 had been reported as of 1/13/21.

Amendment to require masks to be worn during Labor Committee meetings failed on a roll call vote, 5 Yeas, 10 Nays.
