Chairperson Salmon recognized Representative Jeneary for opening remarks on [HSB 43](#), A bill for an act relating to the approval procedures for claims for the military service property tax exemption and including applicability provisions. Discussion was opened. Representative Gjerde offered his support of the bill. With no further discussion, Chairperson Salmon recognized Rep. Jeneary for closing remarks on [HSB 44](#). Rep. Jeneary moved the bill.

The bill was moved and passed by a vote of 17 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Veterans Affairs Committee bill.

Chairperson Salmon recognized Representative Cahill to speak on a resolution she is working on regarding the Iowa Veterans Home in Marshalltown. Rep. Cahill spoke on the proposed resolution and encouraged members of the Committee to sign-on.
