There was discussion of [HF 139](#), and a unanimous roll call vote with 22 ayes which gave approval for the bill to pass to the House floor as a committee bill.

There was discussion for [HF 79](#) and the bill was carried to the House floor as a committee bill with a roll call vote of 20 ayes and 2 nays (Hunter, Wilburn).

[HSB 129](#) was opened for discussion, closing comments were given, and the bill was approved and moved to the floor as a committee bill by a roll call vote with 15 ayes and 7 nays (Mascher, Cohoon, Donahue, Konfrst, Wilburn, Wolfe)
