Chairwoman Senator Sinclair called the meeting to order at 10:00am. Roll was taken silently with 15 members present.

The minutes from the 1/25/21 meeting were approved.

Republican and Democrat Senators caucused at 10:01am. The meeting reconvened at 10:29am.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Zaun for [SCR 1](#). Senator Zaun introduced [SCR 1](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Giddens for remarks in support of the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Zaun. Senator Zaun gave closing comments on [SCR 1](#) and moved its passage. A short form vote was taken, none opposed, and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for [SF 73](#). Senator Cournoyer introduced [SF 73](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Trone Garriott for remarks in support of the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer. Senator Cournoyer gave closing comments on [SF 73](#) and moved its passage. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for [SF 90](#). Senator Cournoyer introduced [SF 90](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Senator Cournoyer offered amendment [SF 90](#).256 and gave remarks. Senator Cournoyer gave closing remarks on the amendment and moved its passage. The amendment was passed on a short form vote. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator J Smith and Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for remarks in opposition to the amended bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer. Senator Cournoyer gave closing comments on [SF 90](#), as amended, and moved its passage. A short form vote, with Senators Celsi, Trone Garriott, J Smith, Giddens, and Quirnbach opposed (10 Yeas - 5 Nays), was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for [SF 117](#). Senator Cournoyer introduced [SF 117](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer. Senator Cournoyer gave closing comments on [SF 117](#) and moved its passage. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Kraayenbrink for [SSB 1069](#). Senator Kraayenbrink introduced [SSB 1069](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Kraayenbrink. Senator Kraayenbrink gave closing comments on [SSB 1069](#) and moved its passage. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair relinquished the chair to Vice Chair Senator J Taylor.

Chairman Senator J Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair for [SSB 1077](#). Senator Sinclair introduced [SSB 1077](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Senator Sinclair was

recognized to offer amendment [SSB 1077](#).231 and gave remarks. Senator Sinclair made closing remarks on the amendment and moved its passage. The amendment was passed on a short form vote.

Chairman Senator J Taylor recognized Senator J Smith for her remarks in support of the bill. Chairman Senator J Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair. Senator Sinclair gave closing comments on [SSB 1077](#), as amended, and moved its passage. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair resumed the chair.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Sweeney for [SSB 1081](#). Senator Sweeney introduced [SSB 1081](#), delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Celsi for remarks in support of the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Sweeney. Senator Sweeney gave closing comments on [SSB 1081](#) and moved its passage. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.
