Chairwoman Meyer recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on [HSB 74](#): *A bill for an Act relating to controlled substances and precursor substances, including amending the controlled substance and precursor substances schedules and including effective date provisions.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 17 Aye (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nay, and 4 Absent (Representatives Anderson, Andrews, Bennett, Fry). The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Meyer recognized Representative Moore, T for opening remarks on [HF 88](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the provision of audio-only telehealth or telemedicine by health care professionals.*

Chairwomen Meyer, A recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on amendment [HF 88](#).135. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 17 Aye (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nay, and 4 Absent (Representatives Anderson, Andrews, Bennett, Fry). The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Meyer recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on [HF 53](#): *A bill for an Act relating to informed consent for medication abortions, and providing penalties.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 11 Aye (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Bush, Dolecheck, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, Osmundson), 6 Nay (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Brown-Powers, Ehlert, Forbes, Mascher, Sunde) and 4 Absent (Representatives Anderson, Andrews, Bennett, Fry). The bill

will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Ann Meyer for opening remarks on [HSB 121](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the prescribing and dispensing of self-administered hormonal contraceptives.*

The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 15 Aye (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Sunde), 2 Nay (Representatives Jeneary, Osmundson), and 4 Absent (Representatives Anderson, Andrews, Bennett, Fry). The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
