On February 3, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. the State Government Committee meeting was held in the Law Library.

At 4:29, Chairperson Kaufmann called the meeting to order and both parties immediately went to caucus.

The State Government Committee reconvened at 4:47.

The roll was taken; all members were present except Representatives Wolfe and Mascher, who were excused.

Kaufmann announced the agenda for the committee meeting would be amended to consider 3 bills, [HSB 127](#), HSBn 155, [HSB 160](#).

Chairperson Kaufman recognized Representative Boden, who introduced [HSB 127](#).

There was a brief discussion, and Boden gave closing comments before moving forward with the bill after a roll call vote of 21 ayes and 0 naves.

The committee moved on and Representative Nordman gave opening comments for [HSB 155](#). Discussion was opened and Representative Hunter requested

Representative Nordman to yield for a question. There was a brief back and forth, which Hunter ended shortly and expressed his disapproval of the bill. After a short

discussion between the other representatives, Nordman gave closing comments. The committee moved the bill with a roll call vote of 20 ayes and 1 naye (Hunter).

Representative Siegrist proceeded to give opening comments on [HSB 160](#). There was brief discussion, closing comments were given, and the bill moved forwards as a

committee bill after a roll call vote of 21 ayes and 0 nays.  
Chairperson Kaufmann configured with the committee to ensure there was no further  
business and the meeting was adjourned at 5:05.
