Chairwoman Senator Sinclair called the meeting to order at 1:33pm. Roll was taken silently with 15 members present.

The minutes from the 2/3/21 meeting were approved.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair relinquished the chair to Vice Chair Senator J Taylor. Chairman Senator J Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair for <u>SSB 1159</u>. Senator Sinclair introduced <u>SSB 1159</u>, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Chairman Senator J Taylor recognized Senator Celsi, Senator Trone Garriott, Ranking Member Senator Quirmbach, Senator Giddens and Senator J Smith, each for remarks in opposition to <u>SSB 1159</u>. Chairman Senator J Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair. Senator Sinclair gave closing remarks on <u>SSB 1159</u> and moved its passage. A record roll call was taken and <u>SSB 1159</u> passed 10-5 with Senators Quirmbach, Celsi, Giddens, J Smith and Trone Garriott voting nay and was moved to the calendar as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair resumed the chair.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for <u>SSB 1068</u>. Senator Cournoyer introduced <u>SSB 1068</u>, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Quirmbach for remarks in opposition to the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer. Senator Cournoyer gave closing comments on <u>SSB 1068</u> and moved its passage. A short form vote was taken, none opposed, and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Sweeney for <u>SSB 1071</u>. Senator Sweeney introduced <u>SSB 1071</u>, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Seeing no discussion, Senator Sweeney moved passage of <u>SSB 1071</u>. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Zaun for <u>SSB 1072</u>. Senator Zaun introduced <u>SSB 1072</u>, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Seeing no discussion, Senator Zaun moved passage of <u>SSB 1072</u>. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for <u>SSB 1076</u>. Senator Cournoyer introduced <u>SSB 1076</u>, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks on the bill. Seeing no discussion, Senator Cournoyer moved passage of <u>SSB 1076</u>. A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill passed and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Sweeney for <u>SSB 1078</u>. Senator

Sweeney introduced SSB 1078, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening
remarks on the bill. Senator Sweeney offered amendment <u>SSB 1078</u> .130 to make
technical corrections to the bill. Senator Sweeney moved the passage of the
amendment. The amendment was passed on a short form vote. There was no
discussion on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Sweeney.
Senator Sweeney moved passage of <u>SSB 1078</u> , as amended. A short form vote was
taken and the bill passed and moved to the calendar under Rule 40.
Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Rozenboom for SSB 1133. Senator
Rozenboom introduced <u>SSB 1133</u> , delivered the subcommittee report, and gave
opening remarks on the bill. Seeing no discussion, Senator Rozenboom moved
passage of <u>SSB 1133</u> . A short form vote, none opposed, was taken and the bill
passed and moved to the calendar.
