On February 9, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. the State Government Committee meeting was held in the Law Library.

Minutes from the previous meeting were approved, as no correction was needed.

Kaufmann announced the agenda for the committee meeting would be to consider 3 bills, [HSB 122](#), [HSB 151](#), [HSB 165](#).

Chairperson Kaufmann recognized Representative Mitchell, who introduced [HSB 122](#). There is an amendment 232. After discussion, Rep. Mitchell moved the amendment and it passed on a voice vote. Chairperson Kaufmann opened the floor for Representative Gjerde to give opening comments on a secondary amendment, 2888. Rep. Gjerde moved the amendment and it passes with a voice vote. Back to [HSB 122](#), as amended. Chair recognized representative Mitchell for closing comments on [HSB 122](#), as amended. It moved to the floor as a committee bill after a roll call vote of 21 ayes and 0 nays.
