There was brief discussion and Representative Kaufmann gave closing comments.

The bill moved forwards as a committee bill with a roll call vote of 22 ayes and 0 nays.

Boden turned the chair back to Kaufmann who recognized Representative Nordman for opening comments on [HSB 125](#).

There was discussion from Representative Hunter and Representative Nordman gave closing comments.

[HSB 125](#) moved to the floor as a committee bill with a roll call vote of 22 ayes and 0

nayes.

Chairperson Kaufmann recognized Representative Meyer, who made opening comments on [HSB 154](#).

There was discussion from members of the committee, all showing support for the bill before Meyer gave closing comments.

There was a roll call vote of 22 ayes and 0 nayes and [HSB 154](#) moved to the floor as a committee bill.

Chairperson Kaufmann recognized Representative Sexton to give opening comments on [HSB 161](#).

There was discussion

The bill moved to the floor as a committee bill after a roll call vote of 19 ayes and 3 nayes (Mascher, Donahue, Konfrst)

Chairperson Kaufmann gave Representative Mascher a list of bills that may be up for consideration by the committee this session, although he assured more would be added.
