Chairwoman Meyer recognized Representative Bradley for opening remarks on [HSB 71](#): *A bill for and Act relating to the authority of dentist relating to the prescribing and administration of certain immunizations and vaccines.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 19 Aye (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Sunde), 1 Nay (Representative Osmundson), and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Meyer recognized Representative Bacon for opening remarks on [HSB 73](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the practice of pharmacy, and providing for a repeal.*

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Aye (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. Chairwoman Meyer recognized Representative Andrews for opening remarks on [HSB 140](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the regulatory provisions applicable to care provided in health care facilities and assisted living programs.*
