Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bacon at 2:40 p.m. following caucus.

Roll call was taken

Minutes from previous meeting were approved.

Chairman Bacon called on Representative Latham to introduce [HF 23](#). Following the introduction, Representative Latham presented Amendment 441, a Strike After Amendment. Representative Judge commented on the bill and amendment.

Representative Latham moved the amendment which passed Short Form.

Representative Latham then moved the bill as amended. A roll call vote was taken with Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist, Smith and Thorup voting Aye, (18 Aye) (one Nay) by Representative Thede, and two excused.

Chairman Bacon called on Representative Jeneary for introduction of [HSB 157](#).

Following this presentation, Representative Jeneary introduced Amendment 292 and requested a Short Form vote. The amendment passed unanimously. Representative Jeneary then requested a Roll Call vote on [HSB 157](#) as amended. The vote was taken with Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist, Smith and Thorup voting Aye, (18 Aye) (one Nay) by Representative Thede, and two excused.

Chairman Bacon called on Representative Fisher for [HF 147](#). Following his closing remarks Representative Fisher moved the bill. A Roll Call vote was taken which passed unanimously with Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist, Smith, Thorup, and Thede voting Aye, (19 Aye) and two excused.

Chairman Bacon called on Representative Gerhold for presentation of [HF 406](#).

Following this presentation, Representative Breckenridge made comments, then Representative Smith commented. Representative Gerhold moved the bill with a Roll Call vote. The bill passed with Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Baxter, Bradley, Fisher, Gerhold, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist and Thorup voting Aye (11 Aye) and Representatives Brown-Powers, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Smith, and Thede voting Nay (eight Nay) and two excused.

Chairman Bacon called on Representative Siegrist to present [HSB 177](#). Following remarks by Representative Cohoon, Representative Siegrist introduced Amendment 485 and requested a Short Form vote on the amendment, which passed. He then moved [HSB 177](#) as amended for a Roll Call Vote. [HSB 177](#) passed with

Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist, Smith, Thede and Thorup voting Aye. (18 Aye) (one Nay) by Representative Jacoby, and two excused.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Breckenridge moved we arise.
