Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bacon

Roll Call was taken

Minutes of last meeting were approved.

Chairman Bacon assigned [HSB 263](#) - Bacon Chair, Baxter and R Smith

Chairman Bacon called on Representative Latham for [HSB 216](#). Following this presentation, Representative Smith made comments in favor of the bill.

Representative Latham made closing remarks then moved the bill. Chairman Bacon called for a roll call vote. The bill passed with 17 Yeas; one nay; three absent. Those voting yea were Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist, Smith and Thede. Representative Jacoby voted nay. Absent were Representatives Bennett, McClintock and Thorup. Yeas 17; Nays 1; Absent 3.

Chairman Bacon then called on Representative Bradley for [HSB 196](#). Representative Bradley introduced [HSB 196](#), and presented Amendment 478. Representative Brown-Powers commented on both the amendment and the bill; Chairman Bacon then called for a short form vote on Amendment 478 which passed unanimously.

Chairman Bacon then called for a roll call vote on [HSB 196](#) as amended. This passed unanimously with Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Mommsen, Siegrist, Smith and Thede voting yea; Absent were Representatives Bennett, McClintock and Thorup. 19 Yeas; 0 Nays; Absent 3.

Chairman Bacon then called on Representative Siegrist for [HF 647](#): Following introduction of the bill, Representatives Jacoby, Cohoon and Bradley made comments. Representative Siegrist then moved the bill. Chairman Bacon called for a roll call vote: Those voting Yea were Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Brown-Powers, Baxter, Bradley, Breckenridge, Cohoon, Fisher, Gerhold, Hall, Jacoby, Judge, Latham, Maxwell, Siegrist, Smith and Thede. Absent were Representatives Bennett, McClintock, Mommsen and Thorup. Yeas: 17, Nays 0 and Absent 4. There being no further business, Representative Jeneary moved we adjourn.
