Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on [HF 115](#): ***A bill for an act relating to emergency care policy and procedure requirements applicable to an ambulatory surgical center.***

Chairwomen Ann Meyer recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on amendment 115.823. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 20 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nay, and 1 Absent.
