Chairwoman Meyer called the meeting to order at 10:30 am.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the previous meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer turned the Chair over to Representative Bradley.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on [HSB 91](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the practice of pharmacy, including the prescription and administration of vaccines and collaborative pharmacy practice.***

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on amendment 91.976. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 17 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Bacon, Bergan, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 3 Nays (Representatives Andrews, Boden, Jeneary), and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairman Bradley turned the Chair over to Representative Meyer, A.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Boden for opening remarks on [HSB 224](#): ***A bill for an act relating to participating network provider pharmacies and pharmacists under Medicaid managed care.***

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Boden for opening remarks on amendment 224.974. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 20 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on [HF 436](#): ***A bill for an act designating certain graduate medical residents as employees***

of the state under the Iowa tort claims Act.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on amendment 436.991. Representative Meyer, A made a motion for a record roll call vote on amendment 436.991. A second was made by Representative Bergan. The amendment passed with a vote of 13 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Bush, Dolecheck, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, Osmundson) 7 Nays (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Brown-Powers, Ehlert, Forbes, Mascher, Sunde) and 1 Absent.

The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer turned the Chair over to Representative Bradley.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Fry for opening remarks on [HF 632](#): ***A bill for an Act relating to information to be provided, recorded, and reported by health care providers relative to certain vaccinations, and providing penalties.***

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Meyer, A. for opening remarks on amendment 632.952. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved by Representative Fry and passed with a vote of 11 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Bush, Dolecheck, Fry, Jeanery, Lundgren, Moore), 9 Nays (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Boden, Brown-Powers, Ehlert, Forbes, Mascher, Osmundson, Sunde), and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairman Bradley turned the Chair over to Representative Ann Meyer.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Jeneary for opening remarks on [HF 701](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the self-administration and storage of bronchodilators and bronchodilator canisters and spacers relative to schools and students.***

The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on [HSB 75](#): A bill for an act relating to disciplinary hearing conducted by professional licensing boards.

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 20 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeaneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nay, and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
