Chairperson Salmon called the meeting to order at 11:30 A.M.

Roll call was taken. Representatives Gaines and McClintock were excused.

The minutes were approved.

There were no bills to assign.

Chairperson Salmon recognized Representative Andrews for opening remarks on [HSB 250](#), A bill for an act relating to participation in and credit for physical education under the educational standards. There was an amendment. Chairperson Salmon recognized Rep. Andrews for opening remarks on amendment 969. Rep. Andrews spoke on the amendment. Discussion was opened. Rep. Andrews moved adoption of the amendment. The amendment was adopted by short form voice vote. Discussion was opened on [HSB 250](#) as amended. Representative Gjerde offered his support of the bill. Representative Hunter asked Representative Andrews to explain the motive behind the bill. Rep. Andrews explained why the committee was approached to bring forth the bill specifically relating to JROTC in high school. Representative Cahill brought up that what the bill does exists already in Iowa Code 256.11, but stated that she was in support of the bill. Rep. Gjerde gave some further background on the purpose of the bill using his own experience as a high school teacher and explaining high school credits. With no further discussion, Chairperson Salmon recognized Rep. Andrews for closing remarks on [HSB 250](#) as amended. Rep. Andrews moved the bill.

The bill was moved and passed by a vote of 15 Ayes, 0 Nay, and 2 Absent.

Representative Gaines and Representative McClintock were the two Absent votes.

The bill will move to the House floor as a Veterans Affairs Committee bill.

As there was no further business to come before the committee, Representative Stone moved to adjourn at 11:45 A.M.
