Meeting came to order at 11:00 am.

Roll call was taken silently.

The March 15, 2021 minutes were approved.

Republican and Democrat Senators caucused at 11:01am. The meeting reconvened at 11:50am.

The Governor's appointment for Department of Education Director of Ann Lebo was considered by the committee. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Goodwin who shared that the subcommittee report was signed with recommendation and gave remarks on his support. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Celsi for her concerns on the appointment. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Goodwin who moved to move Ann Lebo to the Individual Calendar with the committee's recommendation. The motion passed on a short form voice vote with Senators Celsi, J Smith, and Giddens voting no and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Taylor for [HF 318](#).

Senator Taylor introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for his remarks in support and remarks with regard to the fiscal issues. Seeing no further discussion Senator Taylor moved the bill.

[HF 318](#) passed unanimously on a short form vote and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Goodwin for [HF 602](#).

Senator Goodwin introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments. Seeing no further comments, Senator Goodwin moved the bill.

[HF 602](#) passed unanimously on a short form vote and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwomen Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for [HF 644](#).

Senator Cournoyer introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments on the bill. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for his remarks in support. Seeing no further comments Senator Cournoyer moved the bill.

[HF 644](#) passed unanimously on a short form vote and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwomen Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Cournoyer for [HF 770](#).

Senator Cournoyer introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments on the bill. Seeing no further comments, Senator Cournoyer moved the bill.

[HF 770](#) passed unanimously on a short form vote and was moved to the calendar.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Taylor for [HF 793](#).

Senator Taylor introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave

opening comments. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for his remarks in support. Seeing no further discussion Senator Taylor moved bill.

[HF 793](#) passed unanimously on a short form vote and was moved to the calendar. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair relinquished the chair to Vice Chair Senator Taylor. Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair for [HF 744](#).

Senator Sinclair introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments.

Senator Sinclair introduced senate amendment 744.1534 and gave opening comments on the amendment. Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Senator Quirnbach for comments in support of the amendment. Seeing no further comments Senator Sinclair moved the amendment.

Amendment 744.1534 passed unanimously on a short form.

Seeing no further discussion on the bill, Senator Sinclair moved [HF 744](#), as amended.

[HF 744](#) passed unanimously on a short form vote and was moved to the calendar.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair for [HF 802](#).

Senator Sinclair introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments. Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach, Senator Celsi, and Senator J. Smith for comments on the bill. Seeing no further discussion Senator Sinclair moved bill.

[HF 802](#) passed on a roll call vote of 8-5, with Senators Quirnbach, Celsi, Giddens, J Smith, and Trone Garriott voting no, and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused. [HF 802](#) was moved to the calendar.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor relinquished the chair to Chairwoman Senator Sinclair.

Senator Goodwin moved to adjourn.

The committee adjourned at 12:28 pm.
