On March 30, 2021 the Committee Meeting for State Government took place in the Law Library at 2pm.

At 2:00pm, Chairperson Kaufmann called the meeting to order and both parties immediately went to caucus.

The parties reconvened in the Law Library at 2:50pm.

Role call was taken, all members were present other than Representative Bacon, who was excused.

Minutes from previous meetings were approved.

Chairperson Kaufmann announced no further bills are to be assigned for the remainder of the session.

The Chair announced there would be consideration for 5 bills:

[SF 469](#) – Mobile Homes (Jacobsen)

[HSB 270](#) – Rulemaking (Jones)

[SF 540](#) – Barber/Cosmetology (Kaufmann)

[SF 540](#).1555 Proposed Committee Amendment

[SF 568](#) – Technical Election Bill (Kaufmann)

[SF 363](#) – regulation of certain tobacco products (A. Meyer)

Chairperson Kaufmann recognized Jacobsen for opening comments on [SF 469](#).

The Chair opened the floor for comments, and members of the committee discussed the components of the bill.

Representative Jacobsen gave closing comments on [SF 469](#) and it passed as a committee bill with a vote of 14 ayes (Representatives Kaufmann, Boden, Bloomingdale, Bossman, Hunter, Jacobsen, Jones, Lundgren, Meyer, Mitchel, Moore, Nordman, Sexton, Siegrist,)

and 8 naves (Mascher, Bohannon, Cohoon, Donahue, Gjerde, Konfrst, Wilburn, Wolfe), excused(Bacon).

Representative Kaufmann recognized Representative Jones for opening comments on [HSB 270](#).

The Chair opened the floor for comments, and Representative Jones moved the bill, which passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes (Kaufmann, Bacon, Boden-VC, Bloomingdale, Bohannan, Bossman, Cohoon Donahue, Hunter, Jacobsen, Jones, Konfrst, Lundgren, Mascher-RM, Meyer, Mitchel, Moore, Nordman, Sexton, Siegrist, Wilburn, Wolfe) and 0 nays, excused (Bacon).

Chairperson Kaufmann turned the Chair to Representative Boden.

Chairwomen Boden recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on [SF 540](#).

Representative Kaufmann gave opening comments on amendment 1555 to the bill.

There was discussion on the amendment and the committee gave comments.

Representative Kaufmann moved the amendment, which passed with a majority ayes on a voice vote.

Representative Kaufmann gave closing comments on [SF 540](#) as amended, and the bill moved forward with a roll call vote of 20 ayes (Kaufmann, Bacon, Boden-VC, Bloomingdale, Bohannan, Bossman, Cohoon Donahue, Jacobsen, Jones, Lundgren, Mascher-RM, Meyer, Mitchel, Moore, Nordman, Sexton, Siegrist, Wilburn, Wolfe) and 2 nays (Hunter, Konfrst), excused (Bacon).

Chairwoman Boden recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on [SF 568](#).

The Chair opened the floor for discussion, and Representative Hunter gave comments.

Representative Kaufmann gave closing comments, and the bill was moved as a committee bill with a roll call vote of 14 ayes (Representatives Kaufmann, Boden, Bloomingdale, Bossman, Jacobsen, Jones, Lundgren, Meyer, Mitchel, Moore, Nordman, Sexton, Siegrist,)

and 9 nays (Mascher, Bohannan, Cohoon, Donahue, Hunter, Gjerde, Konfrst, Wilburn, Wolfe), excused (Bacon).

Chairwomen Boden returned the Chair back to Representative Kaufmann.

Chairperson Kaufmann recognized Representative Meyer for opening comments on [SF 363](#).

Chairperson Kaufmann recognized Representative Meyer for opening comments on amendment.

The amendment was moved, the amendment carried with a voice vote of majority ayes.

There was discussion from the committee on [SF 363](#), as amended.

Representative Meyer gave closing comments and moved [SF 363](#) as amended, which moved to the Ways and Means Committee as a committee bill with a roll call vote of 18 ayes (Representatives Kaufmann, Boden, Bloomingdale, Bohannan, Bossman, Cohoon, Donahue, Jacobsen, Jones, Konfrst, Lundgren, Mascher, Meyer, Moore, Nordman, Sexton, Siegrist,) and 4 nays (Hunter, Mitchell, Wilburn, Wolfe), excused (Bacon).

Chairperson Kaufmann discussed plans for the next committee meeting, including complimentary pizza, icecream, and pie for the committee.

Seeing there was no further business to come before the committee, Chairperson Kaufmann ajourned the meeting at 3:35.
