The March 30, 2021 minutes were approved.

Republican and Democrat Senators caucused at 11:32 am. The meeting reconvened at 11:45 am. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Goodwin who made a motion to recess until 2:00 pm. The Committee stood at ease. The meeting reconvened at 2:02 pm.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair relinquished the chair to Vice Chair Senator Taylor.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair for [HF 532](#).

Senator Sinclair introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and reserved opening remarks following the amendment.

Senator Sinclair introduced Senate amendment 532.1766 and gave opening remarks on the amendment.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for comments on the amendment. Seeing no further comments Senator Sinclair moved the amendment.

Senate amendment 532.1766 passed on a short form vote with Senators Quirnbach, Trone Garriott, Celsi voting no and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused. Seeing no further discussion on the bill, Senator Sinclair gave closing remarks and moved [HF 532](#), as amended.

[HF 532](#) passed on a short form vote with Senators Quirnbach and Celsi voting no and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused. [HF532](#), as amended, was moved to the calendar.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Senator Sinclair for [HF 813](#).

Senator Sinclair introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor recognized Senator Celsi and Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for comments on the bill.

Seeing no further discussion Senator Sinclair gave closing remarks and moved [HF 813](#).

[HF 813](#) passed on a roll call vote of 8-5 with Senators Quirnbach, Celsi, Giddens, Smith and Trone Garriott voting no and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused. [HF 813](#) was moved to the calendar.

Vice Chair Senator Taylor relinquished the chair to Chairwoman Senator Sinclair.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Taylor for [HF 468](#).

Senator Taylor introduced the bill, delivered the subcommittee report, and gave opening remarks.

Senator Taylor introduced senate amendment 468.1756 and gave opening comments on the amendment.

Seeing no further comments Senator Taylor moved the amendment.

Amendment 468.1756 passed on a short form vote with Senators Giddens voting no and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach for comments on the bill, as amended. Seeing no further discussion on the bill, Senator Taylor moved [HF 468](#), as amended.

[HF 468](#) passed on a short form vote with Senators Quirnbach, Giddens, Smith, and Trone Garriott voting no and Senators Kraayenbrink and Sweeney excused. [HF468](#) was moved to the calendar.

Senator Goodwin moved to adjourn.

The committee adjourned at 2:33 pm.
