Senator Kraayenbrink called the meeting to order.

Attendance was taken silently by the committee secretary. The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

Senator Kraayenbrink entertained a motion to convene a Subcommittee of the Whole on [SSB 1259](#). Senator Lofgren moved and a unanimous vote approved.

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Lofgren for opening comments on [SSB 1259](#). Senator Lofgren presented an overview of the Economic Development Budget. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained questions from the public and the lobby. Hearing none, Senator Kraayenbrink entertained questions from the floor. With no discussion, Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Lofgren for closing comments on [SSB 1259](#). Senator Lofgren simply moved the bill. A record vote was requested. [SSB 1259](#) passed out of subcommittee with 12 yeas; 8 nays (Bolkcom, Celsi, Dotzler, Mathis, Petersen, Ragan, J. Smith, T. Taylor); and 1 present (Koelker).

Senator Kraayenbrink entertained a motion to dissolve the subcommittee. Senator Lofgren moved to arise from the Subcommittee of the Whole and return to Full Committee for consideration of [SSB 1259](#).

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Lofgren for opening comments on [SSB 1259](#). With no additional opening comments, Senator Lofgren introduced amendment 1872. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments. With no discussion, Senator Lofgren simply moved the amendment. Short form vote was requested. Amendment 1872 passed unanimously.

Back on [SSB 1259](#) as amended. Senators Dotzler, Petersen, and Reichman commented. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Lofgren for closing comments. Senator Lofgren moved [SSB 1259](#). A record vote was requested. [SSB 1259](#) as amended passed with 12 yeas; 8 nays (Bolkcom, Celsi, Dotzler, Mathis, Petersen, Ragan, J. Smith, T. Taylor); and 1 present (Koelker).

With no further business to come before the committee, Senator T. Taylor moved to adjourn.
