Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Johnson for opening comments on [SSB 1264](#). Senator Johnson provided an overview of the Infrastructure Appropriations Bill. With no comments from the public or members of the lobby, Senator Kraayenbrink entertained questions from the floor. Senator Petersen was recognized for comments. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Johnson for closing comments on [SSB 1264](#). Senator Johnson moved [SSB 1264](#). A record vote was requested. [SSB 1264](#) passed out of subcommittee with 11 yeas; 8 nays (Bolkcom, Celsi, Dotzler, Mathis, Petersen, Ragan, J. Smith, T. Taylor).

Senator Kraayenbrink entertained a motion to dissolve the subcommittee. Senator Johnson moved to arise from Subcommittee of the Whole and return to Full Committee for consideration of [SSB 1264](#). Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Johnson for opening comments on [SSB 1264](#). With no additional opening comments, Senator Johnson introduced Amendment 2061. With no discussion, Senator Johnson simply moved the amendment. Short form vote was requested. Amendment 2061 passed unanimously.

Back on [SSB 1264](#) as amended. With no discussion, Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Johnson for closing comments. Senator Johnson moved [SSB 1264](#) as amended. A record vote was requested. [SSB 1264](#) as amended passed with 11 yeas; 8 nays (Bolkcom, Celsi, Dotzler, Mathis, Petersen, Ragan, J. Smith, T. Taylor).

[SSB 1265](#) passed out of subcommittee with 11 yeas; 8 nays (Bolkcom, Celsi, Dotzler, Mathis, Petersen, Ragan, J. Smith, T. Taylor).
