Amendment 1890 failed with the votes of 9 ayes (Jacoby Brown-Powers, Gjerde, Isenhart, James, Kurth, McConkey, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wolfe) - 15 nays (Hein, Nordman, Bergan, Bloomingdale, Boden, Graber, Hite, Kaufmann, Lohse, Lundgren, Maxwell, Mitchell, Osmundson, Sieck, Wheeler)- 1 absent (Staed). The representatives discussed and asked questions. The Chair recognized Representative Lundgren for closing remarks on [HF 814](#). Representative Lundgren moved the bill.

[HF 814](#) passed as a Ways and Means bill with votes 15 ayes (Hein, Nordman, Bergan, Bloomingdale, Boden, Graber, Hite, Kaufmann, Lohse, Lundgren, Maxwell, Mitchell, Osmundson, Sieck, Wheeler) - 9 nays (Jacoby, Brown-Powers, Gjerde, Isenhart, James, Kurth, McConkey, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wolfe)- 1 absent (Staed)
