Meyer, Mommsen, Prichard, Running-Marquardt, Siegrist, Sunde, Thorup, Worthan), 1 Nay (Representative Bush), 1 Absent (Representative B. Meyer). The bill will move to a floor as a Transportation Committee Bill.
