Chairman Klein introduced NICK CRAWFORD, Liaison for IA department of corrections and Clel Baudner of Adair, Former Chairmen of the Public Safety committee.

Chairman Klein turned the Chair over to Westrich. Chair Westrich recognized Rep. Klein for opening comments on HSB: 597 (A bill for an act authorizing a criminal or juvenile justice agency to disseminate driver's license photos in missing persons cases.)

Chairman Klein began opening comments on [HSB 558](#). Ranking Member Kressig proposed an amendment to restore Solar energy tax credits. After discussion on the amendment, Ranking member Kressig withdrew consideration got the amendment, Chairman Klein recommending the bill passes moved to hold a vote on [HSB 558](#), with 13 YEAS, 7 NAYS, 1 EXCUSED, [HSB 597](#) passes out of committee to become a committee bill.
